

## MUTUAL CONSENT DIVORCE COMPROMISE DEED

This compromise cum settlement deed is made on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2026  
at Mohali

among;

1. **XXXXXXXX** D/o **XXXXXXXX**, W/o **XXXXXXXX** R/o **XXXXXXXX** Hereinafter called the called "First Party" (which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed and mean to include her Legal heirs, successors-in-interest and assigns), party of the First Part;

### AND

1. **XXXXXXXX**, R/o **XXXXXXXX** Hereinafter called the "Second Party" (which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed and mean to include its Legal heirs, successors-in-interest and assigns), party of the Second Part;
2. **XXXXXXXX**, R/o **XXXXXXXX**  
Hereinafter called the "Third Party" (which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed and mean to include its Legal heirs, successors-in-interest and assigns), party of the Third Part;
3. **XXXXXXXX**, R/o **XXXXXXXX** Hereinafter called the "Fourth Party" (which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed and mean to include its Legal heirs, successors-in-interest and assigns), party of the Fourth Part;

### WHEREAS CLAUSES;

1. **Whereas**, litigation has been pending between both the parties before various Hon'ble courts
2. **Whereas**, the First Party lodged **FIR No. XXXXXXXX under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 109, 120-B IPC** at Police Station **XXXXXXXX** against her husband and **(father-in-law)** and **(mother-in-law)**. The said trial is pending before the Hon'ble Court of **XXXXXXXX**
3. **Whereas**, a Divorce Case No. \_\_\_\_\_ is pending in the Hon'ble Court Principal Judge Family Court Chandigarh.
4. **Whereas**, other cases nos. \_\_\_\_\_ are pending in the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court at Chandigarh.

5. **Whereas**, the Second/Third & Fourth Parties shall file a petition for **quashing of the FIR**, and the First Party undertakes to cooperate fully in the said proceedings.
6. **Whereas**, the First Party and Party No. 2 have agreed to jointly file a **Divorce Petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act** as per the present compromise.

## **TERMS & CONDITIONS OF COMPROMISE**

**That with the intervention of respectable persons, a compromise has been reached between Parties on the following terms and conditions:**

### **(a) Settlement Amount**

The Second Party shall pay a total sum of **Rs. XXXXXXXX** to the First Party and her children namely **XXXXXXX** towards full and final settlement of:

- past, present and future maintenance of both children,
- alimony and permanent maintenance of the First Party,
- **and all other claims including any share in property of self or parents of each other.**

### **(b) Mode of Payment**

#### **i. Payment to First Party**

- A sum of **Rs. XXXXXXXX** shall be paid to first party i.e. **XXXXXXX** by the Second Party in instalments, **as following:**
  - a. **The sum of Rs. XXXXXXXX shall be paid by the Second party to the First party at the time of recording First Motion statement under Section 13-B HMA.**
  - b. **The sum of Rs. XXXXXXXX- shall be Paid by second party to the First Party at the time of recording statement under second motion of 13-B HM. Act. To safeguard the future of children, this sum shall be paid in the form of FDR in the name of daughter**
  - c. **The sum of Rs. XXXXXXXX be paid by the Second Party to the First Party at the time recording of statement before the Illaqua Magistrate regarding quashing of the FIR.**
  - d. **The sum of Rs. XXXXXXXX shall be Paid by the second Party to the First Party at the time of withdrawal of all cases/appeals, pending in the**

Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court at Chandigarh which is filed by First Party against her husband and in laws. And remaining sum of Rs. **XXXXXXX shall be paid at the time of recording of 2<sup>nd</sup> motion statement.**

- e. **The amount mentioned in clause A,B,C,D of Rs XXXXXXX shall be received by First Party towards full and final alimony and maintenance of herself and her children (Past/Present and Future).**

**(c) Quashing of FIR**

The Second Party (accused persons) shall file a petition before the Hon'ble High Court for **quashing FIR**. The First Party shall **cooperate fully**, appear before the Court/Trial Court, and record her statement as and when directed.

**(d) Divorce Petition Under Section 13-B**

Upon signing this Compromise Deed, both parties shall jointly file a **Divorce Petition under Section 13-B HMA** as per these terms. Both parties shall appear and cooperate at the time of recording of their statements.

**(e) Withdrawal of Pending Cases**

Before the recording of the **Second Motion** under Section 13-B HMA: Both parties shall withdraw all civil/criminal cases filed by them **against each other** and undertake not to file any litigation **on the same cause of action** in future.

**(f) Custody of Children**

The **permanent, exclusive custody** of both children, shall remain with the \_\_\_\_\_

**(g) Stridhan, Properties, and Gold Items**

All the claims Qua the stridhan, properties and gold items of both the parties against each other has been settled and after signing of this compromise both the parties shall not initiate any proceedings before any court of law or authority against each other (including parents of each other) qua the the stridhan, properties and gold items

**(h) Non-Interference**

Both parties shall not interfere in each other's personal life henceforth.

**(i) Finality of Settlement**

The total amount of **Rs.XXXXXXXX** shall constitute **full and final alimony, compensation, maintenance** of the First Party and both children.

\*After fulfilment of above said compromise, neither party shall have any claim regarding:

- movable/immovable property belonging to self/ parents of either party,
- maintenance,
- alimony,
- past grievances,
- domestic violence,
- dowry disputes,
- or any monetary, civil, or criminal claims.

\*After receiving the entire settled amount, the First Party shall not claim any further maintenance/alimony/dues from the Second Party for herself or her children.

**(j) Breach of Compromise**

If either party violates or resiles from this compromise, the aggrieved party shall be free to take appropriate legal action as per law.

**(k) Withdrawal of Cases Against Each Other & Family Members**

Both parties agree to withdraw all complaints/cases filed against each other and other's family members.

**(l) Free Consent**

Both parties declare that they have read this compromise, understood its contents, and sign the same **voluntarily**, without any pressure, coercion, threat, or undue influence.
